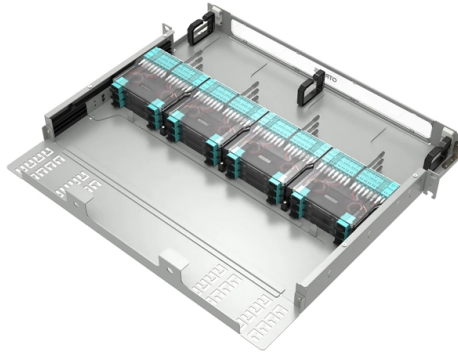

- Splicing Complexity:** More cores require careful organization during fusion splicing to ensure low insertion loss and minimal back reflection.
- Applications:** 4-core pigtails are often used in smaller networks or where fewer connections are needed, while 8-core pigtails are preferred in larger-scale deployments or high-bandwidth environments.

- Fiber Mode:** Both 4-core and 8-core pigtails are available in single-mode (OS2) for long-distance, high-bandwidth applications, and multimode (OM3/OM4) for shorter distances.
- Connectors:** Common connector types include LC, SC, ST, and FC, with LC being popular for high-density racks due to its small form factor.
- Polish Types:** UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) and APC (Angled Physical Contact) are used depending on network requirements for return loss and signal quality.
