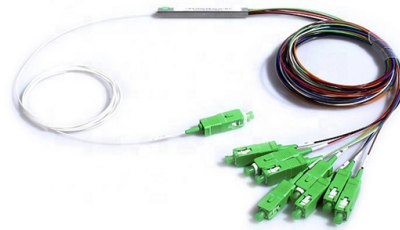


Are there fiber optic cables in East Asia

Market Growth and Deployment The Asia-Pacific fiber optic cable market is experiencing rapid expansion, driven by increasing internet penetration, 5G rollout, and digital transformation across industries. China alone has deployed 59.6 million kilometers of fiber lines, with China Mobile leading the initiative.

Technological Approaches Single-mode fiber (SMF) is widely used for long-distance, high-bandwidth transmission, while Dense Wavelength Division Multiplexing (DWDM) allows multiple signals to travel simultaneously over a single fiber, maximizing capacity without additional cables. Modular and scalable network architectures are increasingly adopted, enabling incremental upgrades and flexible expansion to accommodate urban growth and emerging technologies like 5G, IoT, and AI applications.

Submarine Cable Systems East Asia is also investing heavily in submarine fiber optic networks to enhance regional connectivity. The Asia United Gateway East (AUG East) system, connecting Singapore and Japan with stops in Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, South Korea, and Taiwan, spans 8,900 km and features a high-count fiber pair system for unprecedented bandwidth. It is scheduled for service in Q3 2029 and is supplied by NEC, with major stakeholders including Singtel, AWS, Microsoft, and Chunghwa Telecom. Other projects, like the Vietnam-Singapore Cable System (VTS) and Telekom Malaysia's DWDM network, integrate advanced wavelength multiplexing to increase capacity efficiently.
