This prevents mixing, stabilizes inlet temperatures, and improves cooling efficiency, which is critical for high-density racks producing 10–15 kW or more per rack. Belarusian ODMs implementing CAC typically use modular panels, clear acrylic partitions, and self-closing doors to allow safe access while maintaining airflow control.

High-Density Considerations For high-density deployments, such as GPU clusters or AI workloads, Belarusian ODMs must account for:

- Rack power density:** Modern high-performance racks can reach 15–16 kW, with HPC setups exceeding 100 kW per rack. Cold aisle containment ensures that the cooling system can handle these loads without hotspots.
- Aisle width:** Cold aisles should be at least 48 inches wide to allow safe navigation and sufficient airflow delivery.
- Airflow optimization:** Proper alignment of racks and containment panels is essential to prevent bypass or recirculation, which can reduce cooling efficiency by up to 18% if not sealed correctly.
- Energy Efficiency and Reliability** Implementing cold aisle containment in high-density environments provides:

Reduced energy consumption: By preventing hot and cold air mixing, CRAC/CRAH units operate more efficiently, lowering PUE and utility costs.

Consistent inlet temperatures: Servers receive stable cold air, reducing thermal stress and extending equipment lifespan.

Scalability: Modular containment allows Belarusian ODMs to adapt to varying rack densities and future upgrades without major infrastructure changes.
