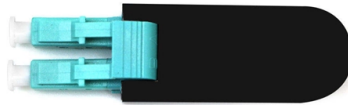


Botswana and Lithuania lay fiber optic cable



AI Overview

Botswana has recently completed the Botswana Kalahari Fiber (BKF) route, connecting the country to the 144-terabit Equiano subsea cable, but there is no confirmed information about a fiber optic project involving Lithuania. Botswana Kalahari Fiber (BKF) Project Botswana's telecommunications provider, Paratus Botswana, completed an 840-kilometer fiber optic route from Gaborone to the Namibian border, passing through key towns such as Molepolole, Letlhakeng, Kang, and Charles Hill. This route, known as the Botswana Kalahari Fiber (BKF), was activated at the end of March 2024 and represents a major investment in the country's digital infrastructure. The BKF connects Botswana to the Equiano subsea cable, which spans from southern Africa to Europe, landing in Swakopmund, Namibia, and Melkbosstrand, South Africa. This connection provides low-latency, high-capacity international connectivity, supporting wavelengths of up to 800 gigabytes and a latency of 123 milliseconds. The project was built entirely by local contractors, involved over 15,000 gum poles, 10,368 splices, and 216 termination joints, and indirectly created around 100 jobs. Strategic and Economic Importance The BKF route enhances Botswana's role as a regional digital hub, providing faster, more reliable internet connections and diversifying routes without third-party involvement. It also facilitates connectivity to neighboring countries and international markets, particularly Europe, through the Equiano cable. The project supports sectors such as financial services, education, and e-commerce, enabling Botswana to participate more fully in the global digital economy.
