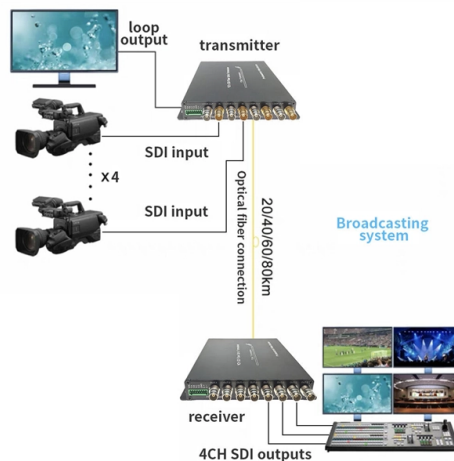

- Aluminum:** Lightweight, corrosion-resistant due to natural oxide layer; suitable for environments with atmospheric exposure.
- FRP:** Pultruded fiberglass with polyester or vinyl ester resin; high resistance-to-weight ratio and excellent corrosion resistance.

- Span and Deflection:** Continuous spans must be designed to limit deflection according to NEMA guidelines.
- Thermal Expansion:** Cable trays expand and contract with temperature; allowances must be made in long runs.
