

Cable to distribution box length

4. **Compliance with Standards:** Ensure the installation follows local codes, such as NEC in the U.S. or IEC/BS standards internationally, which dictate minimum conductor sizes, grounding, and protective device coordination.

Measure the actual path from the supply point to the distribution box, including vertical and horizontal runs. Add extra length (typically 10-15%) to allow for termination, bends, and future adjustments. Use a cable calculator to verify that the selected cable size meets both current-carrying capacity and voltage drop requirements.
