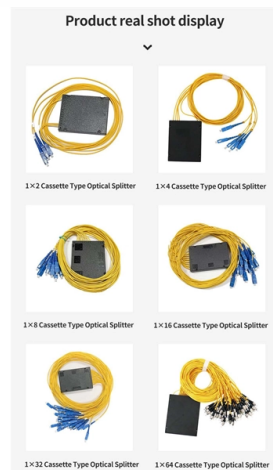


Cable tray cabling construction and network cabling

Setting up a cable tray for network cables involves careful planning, selecting the right tray type, proper mounting, and organized cable routing to ensure safety, accessibility, and future scalability. Choosing the Right Cable Tray Select the appropriate tray type based on your application:

- Ladder trays:** Provide airflow and easy cable entry, ideal for heavy network bundles.
- Perforated trays:** Support lighter loads and allow ventilation.
- Solid-bottom trays:** Protect cables from dust and debris.
- Wire mesh or basket trays:** Flexible for structured cabling and multi-layer setups.

Marking and Mounting Mark the tray route using a laser level or straight line to ensure alignment. Mount the trays using wall brackets (cantilever arms) or ceiling trapeze hangers, depending on the installation location. Supports should be spaced 1.5 to 3 meters apart, depending on tray type and load. Use splice plates to connect tray sections securely and ensure the trays are level before tightening.

Multi-Layer and Clearance Considerations For installations with multiple layers, maintain a vertical distance of at least 30 cm between trays to prevent interference between electrical and network signals. Check for clashes with other services like HVAC ducts, fire pipes, or drainage systems, and coordinate with engineers if adjustments are needed.
