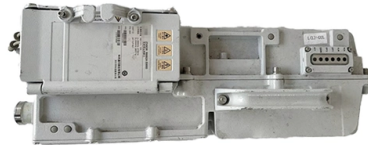


Cable tray construction height standard

Load and Deflection: IEC 61537 specifies that trays must withstand cable weight, environmental loads, and deflection limits. Proper support spacing is critical to prevent sagging and maintain safety.

Changes in Direction: Any horizontal or vertical bends must be supported within 150 mm of joints to ensure structural integrity.

Compliance with Standards The IEC 61537 standard governs metallic cable tray systems, ensuring mechanical strength, electrical continuity, fire resistance, and compatibility with accessories. Following this standard helps maintain safety, prevents overloading, and ensures long-term reliability of the cable management system.

Practical Recommendations Verify the manufacturer's specifications for rail height and load capacity. Ensure support spacing aligns with the tray type and cable load. Use appropriate brackets and fasteners for ceiling or wall installations. Maintain minimum bend radii for cables exiting the tray to prevent damage.
