Avoid sharp bends that exceed the tray's minimum bend radius, as this can damage cables. For rigid trays, use pre-fabricated curved sections or elbow fittings designed for circular installations. Installation Tips Start from one end of the cylinder and gradually secure the tray along the curve, checking alignment frequently. Use temporary supports if necessary to hold the tray in place while fixing brackets. Ensure that the tray does not compress or pinch cables, maintaining the minimum bend radius recommended for the cable type. For long cylindrical runs, consider modular tray sections that can be connected with curved joints to simplify installation. By combining flexible tray types, adjustable brackets, and careful supp...
