Support and Mounting Cable trays must be securely mounted using brackets, clamps, or hangers, with support spacing typically 1.5 to 3 meters apart, depending on tray type and load . Supports should be level and aligned with the tray to prevent sagging. For wall-mounted trays near control cabinets, ensure the mounting does not obstruct cabinet doors or access panels . Tray Type and Material Select a tray type based on cable type, load, and environment. Ladder trays are preferred for heavy power cables due to ventilation, while perforated or solid-bottom trays may be used for lighter or sensitive instrumentation cables . Materials such as galvanized steel, aluminum, or fiberglass are chosen based on corrosion resistance and mechanical strength . Coordination and Safety Check for clashes with other building services and coordinate with engineers before installation . Ensure all materials are inspected and approved, and the installation complies with NEC/IEC st...
