Environmental Conditions: Outdoor installations exposed to wind, snow, or ice may require flat iron supports for added strength.

Cable Type: Heavy-duty power cables or large multi-conductor control cables increase the load on the tray, making flat iron supports necessary to maintain proper bending radii and prevent mechanical stress.
