Slot boxes: Enclosed metal trays that provide mechanical protection and are suitable for BV wires, especially in ceilings or areas with concentrated wiring. Practical Recommendations Use BV wires only in metal slot boxes for distribution lines to comply with safety standards and reduce fire risk. Consider flame-retardant alternatives like WDZ-BYJ wires if installation in cable trays is necessary, as they are low-smoke, halogen-free, and flame-retardant. Avoid stacking or overcrowding wire...
