

# Can fiber optic cable poles be used to hang electrical cables



## Overview

As they can be placed on electrical transmission and utility lines above the voltage rated for non-dielectric cable (typically above 11kV), it allows the existing poles to be re-used. Deploying fiber above ground on poles or towers removes the need for underground digging and is particularly useful when the ground is uneven, rocky or both. Fiber in a duct solutions have a major aesthetic. Cables on poles sharing electrical and telecom/CATV cables must be installed in the telecom space with proper clearance from both electrical cables and other low voltage cables. One way round this is to install aerial fiber cables close to power lines, such as on mixed use poles which also carry electricity. Obviously, these fiber cables need to be resistant to electricity, which can be difficult as many aerial cables contain high tensile steel (HTS) for tensile strength. Do you have communication lines attached to your poles or running near your underground electric cables?

Have telecom companies asked to install 5G antennas on your poles, possibly even above the primary lines?

Are you confident there's proper separation between transformer tanks and communication. Some of the common tools include aerial storage for cables; telescoping poles; fiber heat shrink tube; brackets; blocks; cable saddles; fiber suspension clamp; cable rings, horizontal fiber splice closure, dome fiber splice closure, fusion splicers, etc.
