When cable trays are installed parallel to thermal pipelines, the distance should be no less than 500 mm if the thermal pipeline has insulation, and no less than 1000 mm if it does not.

The cable tray is installed in parallel with the heat pipe. The heat pipe and the insulation layer are not less than 500 mm, and the heat insulation layer is not less than 1000 mm.
