

Connecting the network cabinet to the low-voltage box

Use different colored cables to distinguish between internal and external networks. Label both ends of each cable with port numbers and device identifiers for easy maintenance.
- 5. Connecting Devices** Connect patch panels to switches using short, organized patch cables. Connect servers to switches according to your network plan, ensuring proper port mapping. Verify that power connections are secure and that UPS units are properly integrated for backup power.
- 6. Testing and Optimization** After all connections are made, test each network port f...
