- 6. Organize and Secure Wiring** Arrange wires neatly inside the box using zip ties or cable organizers. Avoid tangling and ensure wires do not touch sharp edges. Leave space for heat dissipation to prevent overheating.
- 7. Testing and Verification** Use a multimeter or insulation resistance tester to check for proper connections, continuity, and insulation resistance. Verify that there are no short circuits and that each breaker functions correctly.
