Cutting, Forming, and Fabrication Sheets of metal are cut using CNC laser cutters, plasma cutters, or punching machines to achieve precise shapes. The pieces are then bent and formed using hydraulic or CNC press brakes to create the box's sides, back, and top. Holes for switches, breakers, cable entries, and mounting hardware are made through punching, drilling, or CNC machining, ensuring accurate alignment and minimal edge chipping (KDM Steel, Coloria Group).
