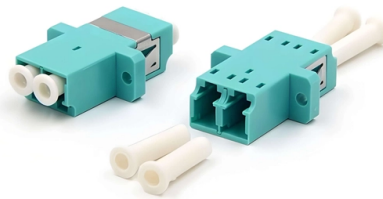


Correct Sequence of Household Electrical Distribution Boxes

- 4. Neutral and Earth Bars** Earth wires are terminated first on the earth bar. Neutral wires are connected to the neutral bar or directly to the RCBO if using individual RCBOs. This order ensures safety and prevents accidental energizing of live circuits during installation.
- 5. Sub-Circuits** Connect each sub-circuit to its respective breaker. Typical household circuits include: Lighting circuits (usually 10–16A MCBs), Socket outlets (13A radial circuits), High-power appliances (16–32A circuits for AC, ovens, or dryers). Ensure the feeder cable to the distribution board can handle the total anticipated load.
- 6. Wire Management and Labeling** Group wires by type: grounds at the bottom, neutrals in the middle, hots on top. Strip sheathing carefully and leave a short piece over the wire end for identification. Label each circuit clearly on a chart or directly on the wire ends (e.g., “Kitchen Lights,” “Bathroom Sockets”) to comply with BS 7671 and facilitate future...
