- Use conduits for additional protection, especially in areas with frequent digging or construction.
- Install detectable marker tape 0.3 meters (12 inches) above the cable to warn future excavators.
- Consider directional boring under roads or sidewalks to avoid surface disruption.
- Follow local and international standards, such as the NEC, ETSI, ITU, or IEC guidelines, which provide minimum depth recommendations based on soil, climate, and traffic conditions.
