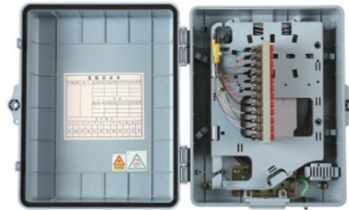


Distance of cable tray swing bracket
