Function and Classification Secondary distribution boxes are part of a multi-level distribution system:

- Level I:** Primary distribution box controlling the entire power supply.
- Level II:** Secondary distribution box supplying a specific area or group of equipment.
- Level III:** Final distribution box for individual equipment or household circuits.

This hierarchical setup ensures that power is distributed efficiently and safely, with each level providing protection and isolation for maintenance or fault conditions.
