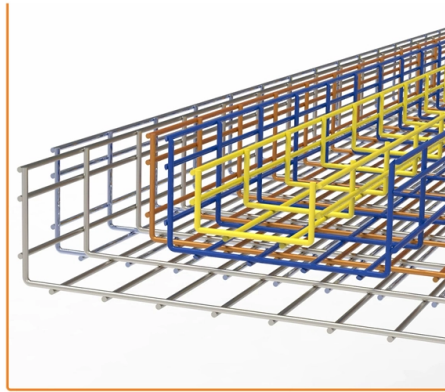


Distribution box placement height

The recommended height for a distribution box is generally between 1.4 to 1.7 meters (4.5 to 5.5 feet) from the floor for easy access and safety.

Residential Installation For residential settings, wall-mounted distribution boxes should ideally be installed at 1.4 to 1.7 meters (4.5 to 5.5 feet) above the floor. This height allows users to access the box comfortably without bending or stretching excessively, while keeping it out of reach of small children. For elderly or handicapped individuals, a slightly lower height of around 1.3 meters is recommended to ensure accessibility. Outdoor boxes should be mounted at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) above ground to protect against water, dirt, and accidental impacts.

Typically, distribution boards with an IP54 protection rating are installed with a maximum height of 1.2 meters for the panel itself, while ensuring adequate working space around the box for maintenance. Consistency in height across multiple boxes in the same area is important for safety and operational efficiency.

General Guidelines and Standards Ground-mounted boxes should be raised 2 to 4 inches to prevent moisture damage. Ensure the installation site is dry, well-ventilated, and free from water or dust. Follow BS 7671 and IEC 61439 standards for safe access, clearance, and protection of live parts. Maintain level and stable installation, with precise positioning of cable entry and exit points. Regular inspections and maintenance are recommended to ensure long-term safety and functionality. By following these height recommendations and standards, a distribution box can be installed safely, conveniently, and in compliance with electrical regulations.
