PoE Pass-Through Functionality A PoE pass-through switch receives power from an upstream PoE source and redistributes it to connected PoE devices. For example, if a switch receives 30 watts from a PoE source, it may use 5 watts for itself and pass the remaining 25 watts to downstream devices . This allows deployment in locations without nearby electrical outlets while still powering multiple devices like IP cameras, VoIP phones, or access points.

Power Limitations The ability of PoE to power a switch depends on the PoE standard and the switch's power budget. Common standards include: PoE (IEEE 802.3af): up to 15.4 W per port PoE+ (IEEE 802.3at): up to 30 W per port PoE++ / UPoE (IEEE 802.3bt): up to 60–100 W per port A switch must be designed to operate within the power it receives; otherwise, it will not function reliably. High-power switches or those with many ports may require a dedicated power supply.
