Overview

It's a three-part process: taking the old stuff down, putting the new stuff up, and sorting out the cables. I use a voltage tester to double-check. Cable trays can provide a safe component of a power, low voltage control, data or telecommunications wiring distribution system. Cables in trays can be easy to mark, find, and remove. Their flexibility makes cable trays a good choice for installation situations that require upgrading. Indeed, to be trapped in a hot, solid container may require a 20-50 percent reduction in the amount of power that a wire carries.
