Overview

Verify that support structures (beams, walls, slabs) can carry the imposed loads with an appropriate safety factor. Minimize deflection of tray sections to prevent cable sagging or pooling of water in outdoor runs. The primary rulebook used in the safe use of cable trays is NEC Article 392.
