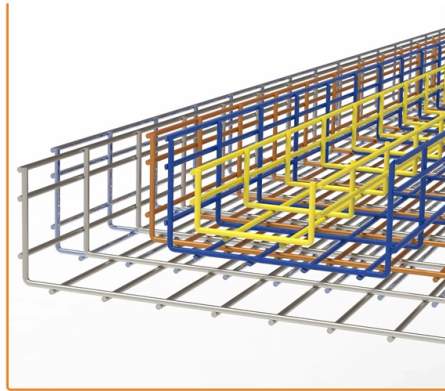


Dominican Republic purchases out-of-town power distribution boxes
