- Load Capacity and Expansion:** Choose a box that can handle current electrical loads and allow for future expansion. Overloading a small box can cause frequent breaker trips or system failure.
- Grounding and Safety Devices:** Ensure proper grounding and include protective devices such as circuit breakers, fuses, and surge protectors. Each circuit should have its own protection to prevent hazards.
- Maintenance and Inspection:** Keep the area around the box clear of obstructions. Regular inspections and maintenance are essential to ensure long-term reliability and compliance with local codes.
