Internal Layout Design: Splice trays, pigtail holders, and adapter panels are installed to allow efficient routing and protection of fibers ().

Integration of Pigtails: Factory-terminated pigtails, with a connector on one end and bare fiber on the other, are inserted into the box. The bare fiber is prepared for fusion or mechanical splicing with the main cable ().
