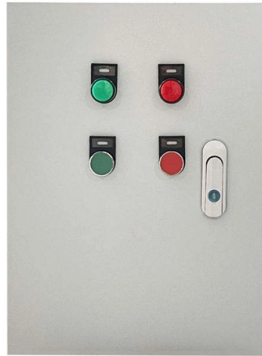


Fiber Optic Cable Companies in Congo

This highlights the growing role of Congolese expertise in fiber optic infrastructure, though it primarily involves network operation rather than cable manufacturing.
