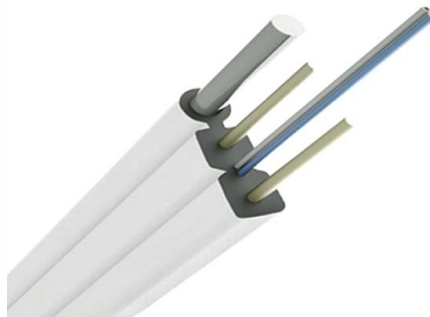


# Fiber Optic Cable Relocation Project Construction
