Splice Methods Fusion Splicing: Uses a core alignment splicer, such as the Fujikura 90S+, which aligns fiber cores precisely and applies a protective sleeve over the splice point. Automated features allow for consistent low-loss splices without manual intervention once the process starts. Mechanical Splicing: Uses splice holders within the tray to align fibers without fusion. Some closures provide accessory kits for storing mechanical splices, typically up to 24 per kit. Installation Considerations Bending Radius: Maintain a minimum bending radius of 10 times the cable diameter for unarmored cables and 15 times for armored cables to prevent fiber damage. Environmental Protection: Closures are sealed with silicone rings or other gaskets to protect against moisture and contaminants.
