You can use a stack cable to connect two switches and set up a stack. However, you are advised to use multiple cables for stacking to increase bandwidths, implement link backup, and ensure reliability.

Which Cables Can Be Used for Stack Connections?

Stack setup just requires ordinary service cables instead of dedicated stack cables. Optical ports can be connected using high-speed cables, AOC cables, or optical modules+fibers.
