

Fiber Optic Switch Storage Configuration



AI Overview

Configuring a storage Fibre Channel switch involves setting up physical and virtual FC interfaces, assigning ports to fabrics, and ensuring proper licensing and port modes for SAN connectivity.

Licensing and Requirements For Cisco Nexus 5000 Series switches, Fibre Channel capability requires a Storage Protocol Services license (N5010SS or N5020SS). Virtual FC interfaces can be configured without a license but will remain non-operational until the license is activated. Ensure your switch has the correct license before enabling FC features.

Physical Fibre Channel Interfaces Physical FC ports can function as downlinks (connected to servers) or uplinks (connected to the SAN fabric). Each port supports multiple modes:

- F (Fabric) port:** Connects to the SAN switch.
- E (Expansion) port:** Connects to another switch to form an Inter-Switch Link (ISL).
- TE (Trunk Expansion) port and SD (Self-Discovered) port:** Specialized modes for fabric management.
- NP (N-Port Proxy) mode:** Used in NPV configurations.

Ports can also be set to Auto mode, where the switch determines the port type during initialization. Virtual FC interfaces support only F mode and a subset of native FC features.

Virtual Fibre Channel Interfaces Virtual FC interfaces are configured on FCoE-capable Ethernet ports, allowing a single physical Ethernet link to carry both Ethernet and FC traffic. These interfaces are useful for server connections and support only F mode.

Assigning Interfaces to Fabrics When configuring a switch as an FCoE-FC gateway, you must assign native FC interfaces and at least one FCoE VLAN interface to each FC fabric. Native FC interfaces handle traffic to the SAN switch, while FCoE VLAN interfaces handle traffic from FCoE-capable servers. All interfaces assigned to a fabric must reside on the same switch, and traffic must ingress and egress through the same gateway. For example, on a Juniper QFX switch, you can assign interfaces like `fc-0/0/0.0`, `fc-0/0/1.0`, and `fc-0/0/2.0` along with `vlan.100` to a fabric named `san_tana`. You can configure blocks of 6 or 12 native FC interfaces, but individual p...
