Examples A 48-port FDB typically has a two-layer design with a rear splice area and front interconnect area, requiring a length of approximately 400–450 mm and width of 250–300 mm. A 32-port wall-mount FDB may measure around 350 mm long and 220 mm wide, suitable for both indoor and outdoor FTTH applications. These dimensions ensure sufficient space for fiber splicing, slack management, and connector access, while maintaining a compact footprint for installation in residential or commercial environments. For precise planning, always refer to the manufacturer's datasheet, as dimensions can vary slightly between models and brands.
