

Fiber optic cable junction box mounting pole

Step 3: Mounting the Box Mark the mounting points on the pole using a level to ensure the box is straight. Drill holes and insert dowels or anchors suitable for the pole material. Secure the junction box with screws or brackets, ensuring it is firmly attached and stable. Position the box at a height that balances protection from environmental exposure and ease of maintenance, typically 8–10 meters for overhead installations.

Step 4: Fiber Cable Preparation and Splicing Carefully strip the outer sheath of the fiber optic cable without damaging the internal fibers. Insert the cable into the designated openings of the junction box. Splice the fibers according to manufacturer instructions, using fusion or mechanical splicing methods. Organize and secure the spliced fibers inside the box.
