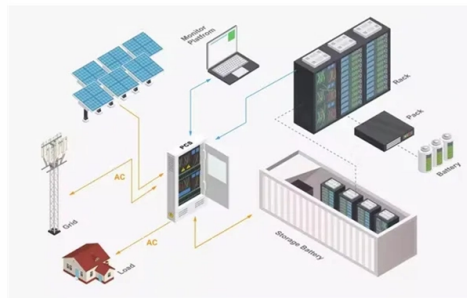


Fiber optic connection still doesn't work even after replacing the router

- Firmware Updates:** Ensure the router and any connected devices have the latest firmware to prevent compatibility issues.
- Test Connectivity:** Use a laptop or smartphone to ping devices on the network or access their admin panels to confirm proper routing.
