

Fiber optic line connection to router

- Connect the ONT to the router:** Use an Ethernet cable to link the ONT's LAN/Ethernet port to the router's WAN or Internet port.
- Power on the router:** Wait for the router's indicator lights to confirm a successful connection.
- Configure the router:** Access the router's admin panel via a web browser (commonly 192.168.1.1) to set up Wi-Fi, change default passwords, and optimize network settings.

Best Practices

- Placement:** Keep the ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets, ideally protected by a surge suppressor.
- Cable handling:** Avoid bending or stressing the fiber cable; even small kinks can degrade performance.
- Optimization:** Use wired connections for critical devices, update firmware regularly, and consider modern Wi-Fi standards (Wi-Fi 6 or 7) to fully utilize fiber speeds.
- Testing:** Run speed tests after setup to verify performance and ensure the connection meets expected speeds.
