

Fiber optic multimode to single-mode conversion equipment

Types of Converters

- Fiber-to-Fiber Media Converters** These standalone devices receive an optical signal on one port, convert it to an electrical signal, and retransmit it as an optical signal on the other port using the appropriate laser wavelength (e.g., 850nm MMF to 1310nm SMF). They are ideal for point-to-point links, extending LANs to WANs, or connecting building networks over long distances. Distances can reach up to 140 km for Fast Ethernet and 80 km for Gigabit Ethernet.
- Mode Conditioning Patch Cables (MCP)** MCPs are duplex patch cords that offset-splice single-mode fiber to multimode fiber, controlling the launch of longwave lasers to prevent differential mode delay. They are suitable for connecting SFP or GBIC transceivers with longwave outputs to multimode backbones.
- Transponders and WDM Systems** Transponders can convert both fiber mode and wavelength, often used in DWDM networks. They allow multimode to single-mode conversion without affecting switch warranties and can be more cost-effective than proprietary single-mode SFPs.
- Advanced Mode Converters** Devices like the TC3004 or TC3006 series convert, regenerate, or extend multimode and single-mode signals for LAN, telephony, or high-speed networks. They support data rates f...
