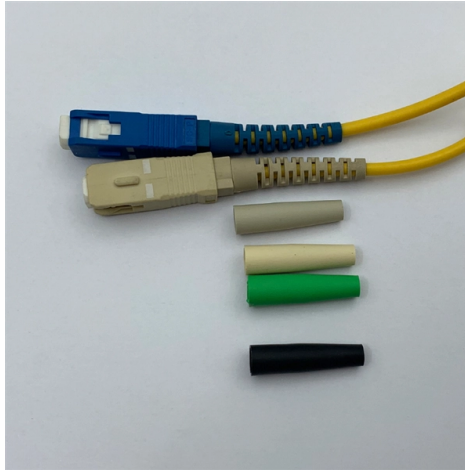


Fiber optic patch cord installation distance



Overview

Unlike long-haul fiber optic cables used for outdoor transmission, fiber patch cords are designed for short-distance signal routing (typically ranging from 1 meter to 100 meters). Accurate length fixing is a crucial aspect in planning, with the goal of ensuring efficient, safe, and future-proof implementation of fibre optic patch cords. These fiber optic cables have been built to exceed industry standards tested for insertion loss and reflectance on within UL certified OFNR (Riser) rated jacket with Kevlar yarn, and are factory terminated. Correct patch-cord installation is essential for maintaining low insertion loss, stable return loss, and long-term reliability in both indoor and outdoor fiber networks. Proper handling, routing, cleaning, bend-radius management, and connector alignment ensure that the optical link meets design. The minimum fiber patch cable length is 1 m for both single-mode and polarization-maintaining fibers. Since there can be issues with even shorter fiber cables we recommend only using fibers with that minimum length. If you need a smaller cable length please contact us and we can discuss the issue.
