Structure and Components

Single-Mode vs Multimode

- Single-mode (OS2):** Light travels straight through the core, ideal for long-distance telecom, CATV, and internet connectivity .
- Multimode:** Light travels in multiple paths, suitable for shorter distances and LAN applications .

Indoor and Outdoor Use

Many 4-core cables are designed for both indoor and outdoor use, featuring UV resistance, water-blocking, and fire safety compliance (IEC standards, EuroClass Cca/B2ca), . Outdoor cables may include rodent protection and pulling aids for installation in ducts or underground .

Color Coding and Installation

The first four fibers typically follow the TIA-598-C color standard: Blue, Orange, Green, Brown. This is important for splicing and termination . In loose tube designs, the tube may be blue or white, with fibers inside following the color sequence.

“Spot” Feature
