Optical Distribution Network (ODN): Comprises optical fibers, splitters, and connectors that distribute the signal from the OLT to multiple homes or businesses. Optical Network Terminal (ONT) / Optical Network Unit (ONU): Installed at the customer premises, it converts optical signals into electrical signals for devices like computers, TVs, and phones. PON networks use optical splitters to share a single fiber among multiple users, typically serving 32, 64, or more homes, which reduces deployment costs while maintaining high-speed connectivity.
