Routers like the NETGEAR Nighthawk RS700S Wi-Fi 7 or ASUS AX6000 Wi-Fi 6 are designed to handle gigabit fiber speeds, multiple devices, and high-bandwidth applications such as 4K/8K streaming, gaming, and video conferencing.
