Green check: Steady means normal; slow blinking is standby. Red/yellow alert: Steady red = serious fault (stop high - power use); blinking red = minor fault (fix soon); steady yellow = low voltage (avoid high - power); blinking yellow = temporary issue (wait or contact if lasting). The CPU and the I/O modules use LEDs to provide information about either the operational status of the module or the I/O. Status LED Blinking Red - Indicates an internal problem (trip actuator coil, firmware error, or mechanism error). The breaker/trip unit should be replaced. Status LED Off - Indicates there is no auxiliary power applied AND. IEC does not mandate a single required color for distribution panel indicator lights, but standards provide guidance through EN 60204-1:2018 (Safety of machinery - Electrical equipment) and IEC 60417 (Graphical symbols for use on equipment).
