Surge Protection Devices (SPD): Protect against voltage spikes from lightning or power surges. Enclosure: Made from durable materials like steel or reinforced plastic to prevent accidental contact and environmental damage. Types and Capacity Home distribution boxes are designed for single-phase power and usually contain 6 to 24 circuits, depending on the size of the house and electrical load. The number of slots or "ways" determines how many breakers can be installed. Large appliances like water heaters, air conditioners, or EV chargers often require dedicated circuits to prevent tripping. Modern boxes may also include smart monitoring features for energy management and real-time fault detection.
