Normal Spans: These trays must have support after every 2 or 3 meters. This will involve purchasing additional hangers and wasting more time drilling holes in the ceiling. Long-Span Trays: These are highly powerful, and they reach a distance of 6 meters (approximately). When installing two cable trays in parallel at the same height, the distance between them should be no less than 0. It also helps reduce the risk of.
