Primary Router Method: Connect the first router to the ONT. Additional routers can be connected to the primary router's LAN ports, functioning as access points or secondary networks. This avoids IP conflicts and allows seamless network management.

Switch Method: If multiple public IPs are available, a fast Ethernet switch can distribute the connection to several routers, each with its own IP.

Bypass or Redundancy Devices: Specialized hardware like bypass switches can allow multiple routers to share a single ONT port for redundancy, though this is more common in enterprise setups.

Bandwidth and Performance Fiber optic connections provide high bandwidth, but the total network performance depends on the routers' capabilities and the number of devices connected. Each router adds potential latency and network management complexity.
