Electricity enters the box via the main breaker from the utility or generator. Power is passed to bus bars and adjusted to usable voltages (e. Breakers direct power to each circuit and trip during overloads. Neutral returns current; ground directs stray electricity to. A bus duct is a specially designed system that distributes power via conductive busbars (often copper or aluminum) wrapped in a strong, protective metallic casing. Unlike many runs of huge cables, bus ducts provide a clean, efficient and cost-effective solution for handling high current in power. A power distribution box (also known as a distribution board or panel) is an essential electrical device that receives power from the main source and distributes it to various circuits throughout a facility.
