

How to check for IP conflicts on an aggregation switch

- Port Security and Violation Logs** Review logs for port security violations. Multiple devices attempting to use the same MAC or IP can trigger alerts, helping pinpoint conflicts.
- DHCP Snooping Table** Inspect DHCP bindings to verify that each IP is assigned to a unique MAC address. Conflicting entries indicate duplicate IP usage.

Command-Line Checks

- On Windows:** `arp -a`
- On Linux:** `arp`
- On managed switches:** `show mac address-table` or `show arp ip-conflict track` (for Huawei switches)

These commands help identify which ports and devices are responding to the same IP, allowing you to match MAC addresses to hostnames and locate the conflicting devices.

Automated Detection Tools

- IP Address Management (IPAM) Tools:** Tools like SolarWinds IPAM can automatically scan your network, detect duplicate IPs, and provide alerts with detailed conflict information including subnet, MAC addresses, and device location.
- Continuous Monitoring:** Modern IP conflict detection software can log historical incidents and send instant alerts when conflicts occur, minimizing downtime.

Best Practices

- Verify DHCP scopes** to prevent overlapping ranges.
- Reserve static IPs** outside dynamic DHCP pools.
- Check for rogue DHCP servers** or cloned devices.
