

How to configure the gateway to the core switch



AI Overview

A core switch gateway is configured by assigning Layer 3 IP addresses to VLAN interfaces, enabling routing, and setting the default gateway toward the firewall or upstream router. Core Switch as a Gateway In a campus or enterprise network, the core switch often functions as the Layer 3 gateway for all VLANs, handling routing between subnets and forwarding traffic to the firewall or internet gateway. This setup allows edge switches to point to the core switch as their default gateway, simplifying network management and improving performance.

VLAN Interface Configuration Assign IP addresses to VLAN interfaces: Each VLAN on the core switch should have a unique IP address that serves as the default gateway for devices in that VLAN.

Enable Layer 3 routing: Ensure the core switch has routing enabled so it can forward traffic between VLANs and to external networks.

Optional VRF configuration: For networks with multiple VRFs, assign VLANs to the appropriate VRF and configure routes to the firewall or transit network accordingly.

Default Gateway Considerations The core switch itself may have a management IP for administrative access. Its default gateway should point to the firewall or upstream router that provides internet access. Edge switches typically use the core switch VLAN interface IP as their default gateway, while the core switch routes traffic to the firewall for external access. In complex networks, a transit network between the core switch and firewall can be used to isolate VLANs from the firewall, allowing the core switch to handle inter-VLAN routing while the firewall manages internet access.

Uplink and Redundancy Configure EtherChannel or Eth-Trunk interfaces for uplinks to aggregation switches or firewalls to increase bandwidth and provide redundancy.

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Core Switch Default Gateway

If your core switch is doing the routing, you don't need static routes on the DHCP server. When you define an IP helper for a vlan the switch will correctly route the packets to the DHCP server.
