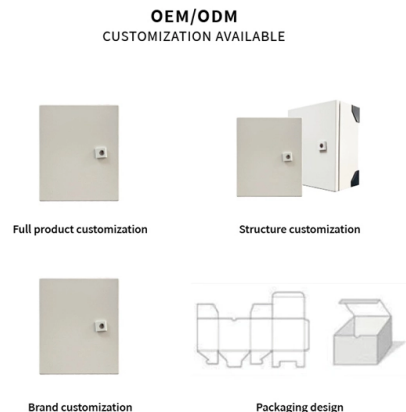


How to connect a router to a fiber optic cable interface
